# Ancient Cities, Scenic Highlands & Southern Wild life



## Day 01 – Arrival | Dambulla Cave Temple | Minneriya Safari

Overnight: Habarana





#### Airport Pickup at Katunayake (BIA):

A warm welcome awaits you at Bandaranaike International Airport as your journey into the cultural heart of Sri Lanka begins.

#### • Dambulla Cave Temple:

Explore the UNESCO World Heritage-listed **Golden Cave Temple of Dambulla**, a 2,000-year-old marvel with vibrant frescoes and over 150 Buddha statues nestled within five ancient caves atop a hill.

#### Lunch in Dambulla:

Enjoy a local Sri Lankan meal with a view of the countryside.

#### Evening Safari – Minneriya / Kaudulla / Eco Park:

Head into the wild for a thrilling jeep safari in one of the "elephant corridor" parks – home to hundreds of wild elephants and a variety of birdlife. A spectacular opportunity for wildlife photography, especially during sunset.

### Day 02 – Sigiriya Fortress & Polonnaruwa Ancient City

Overnight: Habarana

### Morning Visit to Sigiriya Rock Fortress:

Climb the majestic **Sigiriya Lion Rock**, a 5th-century royal citadel rising 660 feet from the jungle. Admire its water gardens, frescoes of heavenly maidens, and panoramic views from the summit.

#### Visit to Polonnaruwa:

Explore the ancient kingdom of **Polonnaruwa**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Wander through ruins of palaces, massive stone Buddha statues, and sacred stupas that tell the story of Sri Lanka's medieval glory.

#### Return to Habarana:

Rest and relax at your hotel amid the peaceful surroundings of the jungle.





### **Day 03 – Scenic Drive to Kandy | Cultural Evening**

**Overnight: Kandy** 

#### Travel to Kandy:

Journey through lush landscapes to **Kandy**, the hill capital and a center of culture and tradition.

#### Evening Cultural Show:

Enjoy a vibrant **Kandyan dance performance**, featuring traditional drumming, fire-walking, and ceremonial dances.

Visit to the Temple of the Sacred Tooth Relic:
 Enter the revered Sri Dalada Maligawa, where a relic of the Buddha is enshrined. This sacred temple is the spiritual heart of Sri Lanka and a must-visit in Kandy.





## Day 04 – Kandy to Nuwara Eliya via Botanical Gardens & Waterfalls

Overnight: Nuwara Eliya

#### Kandy City Tour:

Morning walk around **Kandy Lake**, local shops, and the bustling markets.

#### Peradeniya Botanical Garden:

Explore Sri Lanka's largest botanical garden, famous for its orchid collection, palm avenues, and giant Javan fig tree.


#### Scenic Drive via Ramboda Falls:

Stop for a hearty **Sri Lankan lunch at Ramboda**, with views of waterfalls cascading through the forested hills.

#### Tea Factory and Plantation Visit:

Witness the age-old process of Ceylon tea production and stroll through the picturesque **tea gardens of Nuwara Eliya**, also known as **"Little England"** for its cool climate and colonial architecture.





# Day 05 - Nuwara Eliya | Horton Plains or Scenic Train to Ella

Overnight: Ella

Nuwara Eliya City Tour:
 Visit Gregory Lake, the old post office, and other colonial-er landmarks.



#### **Optional: Horton Plains & World's End:**

Embark on a morning trek to **World's End**, a dramatic escarpment offering one of the island's most breathtaking views. (Recommended for nature lovers and hikers)





#### Alternatively – Train Journey to Ella:

Be dropped off at **Nanu Oya railway station** for the iconic train ride to **Ella** — considered one of the most beautiful in the world. Pass through cloud forests, tea estates, and valleys.





#### Nine Arches Bridge:

Visit the famous **Nine Arches Bridge**, an architectural marvel amidst the misty hills — especially magical if you catch a train crossing.



### Day 06 – Waterfalls, History & Safari Adventure

Overnight: Yala

#### Rawana Falls:

Visit the majestic **Rawana Falls**, cascading down a steep rock face near Ella — a perfect spot for photos and a refreshing break.

#### Buduruwagala Ancient Rock Statues:

Discover the towering 10th-century **rock-cut Buddha statues** hidden in a tranquil forest — a peaceful and lesser-visited archaeological site.

#### Evening Safari at Yala National Park:

Experience a thrilling jeep safari in **Yala**, home to elephants, sloth bears, crocodiles, and the **highest density of leopards** 

in the world.





# Day 07 — Southern Coast | Whale Watching | Galle Fort | Departure End at Colombo or Airport (Katunayake)

Transfer to Mirissa:
 Head to the sun-kissed beaches of the southern coast.

Optional Whale Watching (Seasonal):
 Take an early morning boat ride from Mirissa to see blue whales, sperm whales, and dolphins in their natural habitat (available during peak months: Nov–April).














- Visit Galle Fort:
   Explore the historic Galle Fort, a UNESCO site built by the Portuguese and fortified by the Dutch. Walk along the ramparts, lighthouse, colonial streets, and boutique shops.
- Ahangama Stilt Fishermen (Photo Stop):
   Witness the unique stilt fishing tradition of Ahangama one of Sri Lanka's most iconic images.
- Evening Drop-off at Colombo or Bandaranaike International Airport (BIA):
   Conclude your unforgettable Sri Lankan journey with a relaxing drive back to the capital.
